



CAMPING MAP & REMINDERS

- The **ONLY** RV entrance will be the south entrance of Skagit River Park, 1510 E. Whitmarsh Rd.
- Campers can begin arriving Thur. June 26th, 3pm-8pm. *Arrivals after 8pm who self park may be subject to move upon tournament directors request and relocated.
- All campers must check in to receive RV & Camping pass.
 - Proof of purchase will be required upon checking in.
- Following check in, tournament staff will direct RV's to designated areas. *Passes must be visibly displayed on dash or window.
- Friday campers must check in at the main office to receive a pass and designated parking area.
 - May experience delayed parking due to accessibility
- BBQs are allowed for cooking, however must be covered & fueled with propane, electricity, or charcoal (no wood/pellet)
- **NO PETS** are allowed on the fields, no exceptions (service animals must be identified with proper certifications)

Bathrooms

- Toilets and sinks with running water can be found by the playground on the main complex and by the shelter on Dike District Fields, these can be accessed 24/7 while camping.
- Honey Buckets are located around the complex and can be accessed 24/7 while camping.
- No showers are available.
- All bathroom locations can be found on the Camping Map, noted with a blue symbol.

Grills/Campfires/Generators

- There is a burn ban in effect for Skagit County, **NO OPEN FIRES OR FIRE PITS**
- BBQs are allowed for cooking, however must be covered & fueled with propane, electricity, or charcoal (no wood/pellet).
- Generators are allowed to be used.

Pets

- **NO PETS** are allowed on the fields, no exceptions (service animals must be identified with proper certifications)
- Dogs are allowed in camping areas and on the perimeter of the park, however must remain on a leash at all times when outside of your RV/Tent.
- Please refrain from allowing dogs to run on the fields after games are done for the day.

Garbage

- There will be garbage cans around camping areas for your use. When the bag is full, please remove the bag and place it next to the can, there will be additional bags at the bottom of the can, please help us by replacing the bag if the original one is full. A worker will come and collect the bags and take them to the dumpster.

Noise Ordinance

- The city of Burlington has a noise ordinance where quiet hours begin at 10:30 PM, please be mindful of neighbors.
